The building's first major addition was completed in 1994 and named the "Peter Spiro Center for Environmental Ethics," in honor of Ms. Spiro's husband. Designed by architect Oscar Newman, the Spiro Center is a modern glass and concrete building that sits on a natural ridge just behind the church campus center. The Center is equipped with parking, handicap-accessible facilities, classrooms, a computer laboratory, and meeting spaces. Founded in 1986, the Miller Building is a contemporary art gallery and performance space on the campus of Johns Hopkins University. It was designed by the firm of Peck and Bond and opened in 1993. It is named for John and Virginia Miller, benefactors who provided financial support for the creation of the new building and were also influential in the development of the arts at Hopkins.
