Gambino said on Wednesday that Turkey needed Europe and the EU, "and Hungary, in particular, has been the best friend of Turkey, the best friend of Europe," adding that he believed Erdogan "was a great friend of Orban". Gambino urged the EU to adopt a clear position on the migration issue in the coming weeks, "but above all, to not help Turkey in the migration matter, which is dangerous for Europe." The former Italian and current European Parliament president, Gianni Pittella, said Turkey and Hungary's stance on the EU, as well as differences on migration, could play out in European elections. "Turkey and Hungary have some significant divergences and, within that divide, they differ on migration and have an agenda of their own. We have to make sure that we tell them that they are on the wrong path and that they are not going to find a place in the European family." Pittella said the European Green Party was open to working with both parties. "We have an opinion on each one of them. We are open. The Greens are open to work with either.
